

7. OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP OF POLICY ACADEMY MEMORIAL "MATKO MARŠIĆ"- 2019

PROPOSITIONS OF CHAMPIONSHIP:

The championship consists of a classic, fast and practical shooting situation scenario. Results - according to IPSC mode of calculation-earned points, reduced by penalty points and divided with time.

CATEGORIES OF COMPETITORS

Individually and team (max. 3 members)

- Each competitor can use his weapon and ammo minimum 9 mm caliber PARA.
- For international teams members (Police school and Police Academies who get the special official invitation of Police academy Zagreb), if necessary weapon and ammunition can be provided.

CATEGORY 1 - "PRODUCTION"

Weapons without any improvements, changes and/or additions, with a maximum of 15 rounds in the magazine, without optical or electronic sightings.

In this category it's permitted to use only weapons suitable for everyday police use (duty guns and holsters must have at least one safety). Magazines pouches has to be police type, **not sport** (can be open or closed – shooters choice). In this category, sports holsters **are not allowed**.

If necessary, Range Officers will done categorization of guns and weapons at the competition.

CATEGORY 2 - "STANDARD"

Weapons with user improvements, changes and / or add-ons, with a maximum of 15 rounds in the magazine, without optical or electronic sightings (more detailed rules in accordance with applicable IPSC rules for "Production / Standard / Classic Division"). In this category, sports holsters **are allowed**.

ENTRY FEE FOR PARTICIPATION

Entry fee for participation in championship is HRK 100 or € 15 per competitor and will be collected during registration process on the range. Entry fee has humanitarian purpose and encouragement of the work of the Police Solidarity Foundation.

The Foundation of Police Solidarity will received funds allocated to the necessary police officers and their families in accordance with their powers.

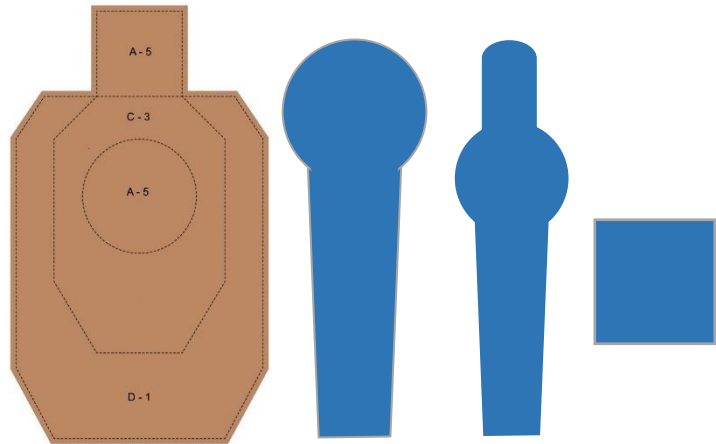

APPEARANCE AND TARGET SCORING:

A cardboard target for practical shooting in accordance with IDPA rules (with allowed modifications and customization of the organizer).

Metal reactive target – small square target - size 15x15 cm and IPSC poppers. Metal target will fall when it is hit. Hitting the metal target worth 5 points.

SAFETY MEASURES DURING COMPETITION

1. Every weapon should be treated as load and ready to fire.
2. Never point the weapon in place you do not want to shoot.
3. Do not hold your finger on the trigger except when you fire the gun.
4. Always be sure what is the target, and what is behind it.
5. Gun handling is approved only after the command of Range Officers.

Failure to observe the above mentioned actions and / or breach of the any security measures will be disqualification from the competition.

During the competition, it is imperative to use eye and ear protection.

TIME AND PLACE OF CHAMPIONSHIP

The championship will take place at the shooting range Vrbovec on Sunday, March 22, 2020, from 08.00 to 17.00 hours.

Schedule of competitors by time and groups for each stage will be announced, a few days before the competition.

OBLIGATIONS OF COMPETITORS:

1. Take the weapon and equipment to the competition.
2. Take precautionary measures and actions while handling weapons, and obey the orders of Range Officers.
3. Get at least 15 minutes before the start of the shooting time, to make the registration and inspection of the equipment

Each competitor must have a holster for safe disposal and carrying of weapons when the weapon is not in use and at least one magazine pouch. If the participant does not have his weapon and equipment (holster and rig) he can use the one provided by the organizer (official police rig of the Republic of Croatia and pistols CZ 75B, HS-9), but it is also **necessary to ask the organizer earlier.**

AWARDING CEREMONY:

- Prizes, medals and cups for the overall singles and team winners in all categories.
- **AWARDING CEREMONY** – with banquet at Police Academy.
